Current Environmental Initiatives

- **Guest Communication & Engagement**
We actively encourage guests to participate in sustainability efforts through clear communication, including towel and linen reuse programmes in all properties. These initiatives help conserve water and energy during each stay.
- **Digital-First Approach**
To minimise paper waste, we prioritise digital marketing and guest communications, replacing printed collateral wherever possible.
- **Sustainable Booking Platforms**
Where available, we participate in sustainability programmes offered by booking partners such as Booking.com's Travel Sustainable initiative. This helps highlight each property's environmental efforts and informs guest choices.
- **Support for Electric Vehicles (EVs)**
Properties with suitable infrastructure have installed EV charging stations to support low-emission travel and contribute to the UK's transition to electric mobility.
- **Energy Use & Waste Reduction**
We are committed to increasing recycling rates, reducing single-use plastics, and minimising energy consumption across operations, particularly in food & beverage and housekeeping departments. Water consumption is monitored per hour per property.
